In terms of energy generation the current business-as-usual trajectory already commits us to over 2°C warming – a threshold scientists have described as being between “dangerous” and “extremely dangerous” – within decades.

It is clear that a complete transformation of the energy sector is needed, driven by strong climate policies, both nationally and locally. It is vital that Norwich City Council aligns itself with activities and developments that genuinely deliver sustainable, renewable energy.

Burning straw pellets is extremely unlikely to deliver environmental, economic or social benefits for the people of Norwich. Instead the local disruption, unacceptable and unnecessary pollution and the misuse of public money subsidising the burning of straw should be opposed by the City Council.
