ORGANIC FOOD

The Greenhouse has promoted and provided an organic plant-based diet and menu since 1994, the kitchen relying on charitable grants to cover the staff costs necessary to train and develop volunteers. However the Greenhouse is now in the process of reducing its café service in order to focus on the possibilities created by Extinction Rebellion.

With 800+ eating places in Norwich (many providing plant-based options), the Trust has decided that providing food is no longer a priority (with sincere apologies to our long-standing customers).

Given the historic use of the Greenhouse kitchen for training and education in relation to organic food, its use remains an option for a project that makes the necessary links.
